What To Do During an Active Shooter Situation

Call 911 only when it's safe to do so



1. RUN

- ✓ Have an escape plan
- ✓ Evacuate
- ✓ Leave your belongings
- ✓ Help others if possible
- ⊗ Don't move wounded people

2. HIDE

- ✓ Stay out of shooter's view
- ✓ Lock and block doors
- ✓ Keep options for escape
- ✓ Silence your cell phones
- ⊗ Don't make noise



3. FIGHT

- ✓ Act aggressively
- ✓ Incapacitate the shooter
- ✓ Throw objects
- ✓ Yell and call for help

>> **Fight only as last resort. Be prepared.**



Call 911 and provide clear informations


When law enforcement arrives:
